## Re: Webinar Dates to Outline HRIS Changes for Teaching Stream Appointments, Including New Ranks

This is an update to the <u>message sent December 17, 2015</u> regarding changes to the <u>Policy and Procedures on Academic Appointments</u> (PPAA) for the Teaching Stream.

The Office of the Vice-Provost, Faculty & Academic Life and the team in HR Information Systems & Process Optimization are completing the changes in HRIS including the creation of the new ranks and an improved structure to differentiate full-time continuing appointments from contractually-limited appointments in the teaching stream.

Full-time teaching stream faculty records will be converted centrally on January 25, 2016 and will include assignment of the new ranks for those who elected to be covered by the PPAA. The conversion of records will also involve moving continuing teaching stream positions to a new employee subgroup (FA, Teaching Stream, Continuing) and some changes to IT9023 Rank and Tenure Information (to be renamed Rank and Status Information).
